MESSAGE FROM THE HEAD TEACHER



The current terrible Coronavirus Pandemic spreading across the world is a stark reminder that we do not know what the future will hold. As parents and Schools, we often speak of preparing children for the challenges ahead. If nothing else, the Coronavirus crisis is an example that we must all remain committed to this mission.

In preparing the children for the future, it is not so much academically that is crucial but more- as people, as Global citizens, as leaders. Hence, an integral part of each child's education at St. Saviour's School Ikoyi is to build character through a focus on Personal Goals. The qualities and attributes we aim to develop in children here will thread all the way through their learning journey and continue into adult life.

At School, we have identified eight specific Personal Goals designed to enhance our children's learning and character development; not just to help children cope with unfamiliar situations and activities, but to give them confidence and further understanding when engaging in situations both independently and interdependently. Of course, they do not require *Cooperation, Adaptability, Enquiry, Respect, Resilience, Communication, Thoughtfulness and Morality* all at once. Personal Goals are utilised based on their relevance to the situation, by the children.

As children grow and become more independent thinkers and learners, they too are able to reflect more on the importance of these goals. As mentioned, each Personal Goal will reappear along a child's development path continuously.

At the core of all learning is an aim to empower children with various personal and social skills, qualities and coping mechanisms; to prepare them for their lives as adults in this ever-changing world. As Martin Skelton, cofounder of Fieldwork Education, says, "The kinds of children we are helping to develop is a shared responsibility. Experiences children have at school impact on the kinds of people they will become in the future."

A child who has many experiences with all the Personal Goals at every stage of their learning may of course still not become a potential world leader by the end of their education. However, if many of our world leaders today were more mindful of the objectives of Personal Goals such as *Morality, Respect, Cooperation and Thoughtfulness*, for example, in their positions of power, the world would surely be a better place!
