Make sure you have your school bag with your lunch box and water bottle ready to alight from the car, as no adult will be allowed to come down from the car to assist you. Also, being very organised and independent with these will enable you come down quickly at the horseshoe (Y1 to Y6).

The school will provide all your stationary. These will be kept in clearly labelled zip lock bags which will remain in school.

Every child will bring 'tea' towels to place on the table when they are eating.

Teachers will wear visors when working with children in the class and during picking up and dropping off duties.

Every child will move around in their bubble and are to maintain social distancing with other classes.

Every class has been assigned a designated play area.

Other than your school bag with your reading folder and any of the other thing already mentioned above, do not bring any other items to school.

Every one will have a designated seating position which must be maintained at all times in all lessons.

Every child will be dropped off and picked up in the horseshoe, except Reception children - they will be dropped off and picked up at the front entrance.

Everyone in school will follow the new 'one way' system of movement.

Homework will be done digitally using HLP platforms and sometimes in books.

Every child will bring a clearly labelled water bottle to school.
